Changes to the EU Quota functionality on Wine Online

The following changes have been made to the EU Quota functionality on Wine Online:

1) Export Certificate Application, Declaration of Loading and Cancel Declaration

The indicators of EU Quota usage on Export Certificate Application, Declaration of Loading and Cancel Declaration have been removed. The functionality has been replaced with an EU Quota Declaration which can always be accessed at:

Documentation - Documents - Applications - EU Quota Declaration

If you are applying for an Export Application or maintaining a Declaration of Loading and the destination Country is an EU Country, the system will automatically redirect you to the EU Quota Declaration, once the application has been submitted. You will thus always have to submit an EU Quota Declaration for all exports to the EU, even if you are not making use of quota.

Wine Online will determine the TARIC Code classification for the export transaction and give guidance with regards to the benefits applicable, if any. You will thus be able to see if the transaction will be deducted from your existing allocation held, or if it carries a preferential tariff rate with no need for an allocation.

2) EU Quota Reports

The following reports are no longer in use and have been discontinued:

EUR1 Certificate Report

EU Allocation Litres Report

EU Quota Application Report

EU Quota Reallocation Period Report

The EU Allocation Summary Report will now serve as the main report for EU Quota allocations and usage reporting. You will be able to view your current allocation and usage figures as well as the applicable usage transactions directly from this report.

To view the individual transactions applicable to the usage figures, click on the volume used on the generated report.

Changes to your usage in quota, normally done on the EUR1 Certificate Report should now be done through the EU Quota Declaration by editing the applicable transaction.

3) EU Quota Sub Allocations

The functionality with regards to EU Quota Sub Allocations with regards to Country, Consignee and Type of Product have been removed, due to the increasing problems experienced with the maintenance of the sub allocations. Thus if you sub allocate your allocation it will need to be done within your own systems and can no longer be done on Wine Online.

4) Invoice Declarations for Approved Exporters

The Invoice Declaration has been replaced with an Origin Declaration as per the new trade agreement. The document will serve the same purpose as the Invoice Declaration and its function and use will be the same as the Invoice Declaration. The same rules and procedures that currently apply to the issuing, cancelling and use of Invoice Declaration will apply to the Origin Declaration.
