**THE RE-ALLOCATION OF WINE EXPORT QUOTAS UNDER THE ECONOMIC PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT (EPA) BETWEEN THE EUROPEAN UNION (EU) AND UNITED KINGDOM (UK) WITH THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA FOR THE YEAR 2026**

Dear All

Please note that the re-allocation of the wine export quotas is scheduled for June 2026 with the implementation of the reallocation effective from 01<sup>st</sup> July 2026. Exporters who have not used a minimum of 40% of their quota for both Bottled and Bulk wine will run the risk of their allocations being reduced.

Exporters will be afforded an opportunity to motivate to retain their quota from 18<sup>th</sup> May 2026 to 12<sup>th</sup> June 2026. Motivations must be captured on Wine Online system; no e-mailed motivations will be considered. Failure to motivate will lead to a reduction in the allocations.

Detailed instructions regarding the motivation process on Wine Online will be provided closer to the reallocation period.
